PARKING FEES

Sonoma County Fairgrounds is now charging a \$7.00 daily parking fee. They do not take credit cards, you must have cash. I hear the Bay Team is talking to them about it but as of right now it is \$7.00 a day to park and you need cash. Please do not take it out on the parking attendants. They are not responsible for the parking fee. Please be nice to them. We will let you know if there is any change in the parking fee.

NOVICE AND OPEN COMPETITORS, if you have any questions or need help with anything please come to the score table and someone there will be happy to help you. If this confirmation is confusing to you and you need some further explanation, contact Patty Fornelli at: 916-774-6016 or agilityentry@mycci.net and she will help you make sense of it. If you have conflicts when running your dog or any problems at the show come to the secretary table and we will help you.

MOVE-UPS: All pre-show move ups must be received by 6pm, Monday, January 21. The AKC requires move-ups to be in writing. You may send an email for a move-up to agilityentry@mycci.net with your name, your dog's call name, the name & date of the trial and what class you want the dog to be moved to. If you miss the deadline for move-ups, you may move your dog up the first day of the show for any **subsequent** days even if you are not showing a dog that day. In addition a friend may do the move-up for you if you are not there. However you may not move up the day of the show for that day.

There will be day-to-day move-ups at the show provided the Trial Secretary receives them within 15 minutes after the end of the last class. **There will be no move-ups in the morning before the start of the trial.**

However, a dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions: The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from the Novice "A" class to the Novice "B" class.

From the South via US 101 Take 101 north to Santa Rosa. Exit onto Highway 12 exit towards Sonoma (east); stay in the right-hand lane. From Hwy 12, take the first--almost immediate--exit (South E Street/Downtown). Go straight through the light at the bottom of the off ramp, which puts you onto Bennett Valley Road. You will almost immediately pass, on your right, the fairgrounds racetrack and the fair marquee; take your next right onto Brookwood Ave. At the end of Brookwood, turn right onto Allen, which becomes Aston Ave. Just ahead on your right is a booth entrance for the fairgrounds. Enter and take the right side road. Head straight until you see the Lytle Cow Palace sign on the building. Turn left before the building and park in the marked parking areas.

From the East via CA 12 from Highway 12, westbound, take the Downtown exit. Turn left at the stop light onto Brookwood Ave. At the end of Brookwood, turn right onto Allen, which becomes Aston Ave. Just ahead on your right is a booth entrance for the fairgrounds. Enter and take the right side road. Head straight until you see the Lytle Cow Palace sign on the building. Turn left before the building and park in the marked parking areas.

SET-UP: NO SET-UP ON THURSDAY! Friday morning we will move any set-ups that are there.

Set-up Friday morning. **Volunteers helping to unload the trailer and set up the rings will be allowed to come early** and get their choice of places to set up. We will start unloading at 6:30pm. **DON'T FORGET TO GET YOUR VOUCHERS.** General Exhibitor set up time is 7:30am. Setting up before that time is not fair to the people who follow the rules. The people who come early to help should have first choice of where to set up. Absolutely no exhibitor set ups, x-pens, crates, chairs etc. are allowed before this time.

VOLUNTEERS: THANK-YOU, THANK-YOU, AND THANK-YOU. White boards will be set-up outside of the rings if you have some spare time. Karen Johnson and Julia O'Rourke are our chief ring stewards. Volunteers will receive a \$2.00 voucher for each class

worked. Volunteers who work the last class of the day will get a \$4.00 voucher.

SECURITY:

There will not be a security guard on the agility site. It is a large, open area. Leave things at your own risk.

MEASURING:

Our judges are not Volunteer Measuring Officials for a permanent height card. They will be available to measure between classes This weekend only. If you need to be measured you must be measured before you run. Come by the secretary table if you need help.
