SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The DACV and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The DACV reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the DACV or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

These clubs do not agree to arbitration as stated on the AKC entry.

REFUNDS

No refund will be given for overpayment of \$6.00 or less.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, weather or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

If an entry was made online, no refund of the service fee will be refunded for any reason. Refunds for injured dogs or handlers: 50% refunds will be given for a dog or handler that has a note from their veterinarian or doctor saying they cannot participate in the show. The doctor's appointment must have been before the show.

Full Entry fees will be refunded if an entry is pulled before the closing date/ time. However, online convenience fees will not be refunded.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. Bitches in season are not allowed on the show grounds. WAITLIST

MOVE-UPS

All pre-show move-ups must be received by 6 pm, Monday, April 8, 2019. The AKC requires move-ups to be in writing. You may send an email for a move-up to LTPagility@aol.com with your name, your dog's call name, the name & date of the trial and what class you want the dog to be moved to. If you miss the deadline for move-ups, you may move your dog up the first day of the show for any subsequent days, even if you are not showing a dog that day. In addition, a friend may do the moveup for you if you are not there. However, you may not move up the day of the show for that day.

There will be day-to-day move-ups at the show, provided the Trial Secretary receives them within 15 minutes after the end of the last class. There will be no move-ups in the morning before the start of the trial. A PACH rosette and pin will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their PACH A flat green ribbon will be awarded to all dogs that earn a qualifying score. A QQ(or QQQ) pin will awarded to all Master dog and handler teams gualifying in both MASTER STD and MASTER JWW (plus T2B or Master FAST) on the same day, while quantities are available. A Rosette for "High Scoring Cocker Spaniel " in Excellent/Master (regular & preferred) will be awarded on Friday based on most Q's and least number of faults. A tie will be decided by considering seconds under course time. T2B : 10.9 & 8 point ribbons will be awarded to all dogs achieving 10. 9 or 8 points. T2B pins will be available to all dogs achieving their T2B title. All prizes, awards and ribbons must be picked up before the end of the show. No ribbons, etc., will be mailed after the show.

**The Schipperke Club of America will support entries on Friday. April 12, 2019, with rosettes and trophies to the High Scoring Schipperke. When two schipperkes competing in the trial have the same score, regardless of the class or division in which it was earned, the winner of the High in Trial award shall be the schipperke running under the ACT with the greatest difference between its running time and the Assigned Course Time (ACT minus running time.) RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
