#### **REFUNDS**

No refunds will be given for overpayments of \$6.00 or less.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, a public emergency, act of a public enemy, weather, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

#### **MOVE-UPS**

All pre-show move ups must be received by 6pm, Monday, December 23, 2019. The AKC requires move-ups to be in writing. You may send an email for a move-up to <a href="mailto:agilesam@gmail.com">agilesam@gmail.com</a> with your name, your dog's call name, the name & date of the trial and what class you want the dog to be moved to. If you miss the deadline for move-ups, you may move your dog up the first day of the show for any subsequent days, even if you are not showing a dog that day. In addition, a friend may do the move-up for you if you are not there. However, you may not move up the day of the show for that day.
