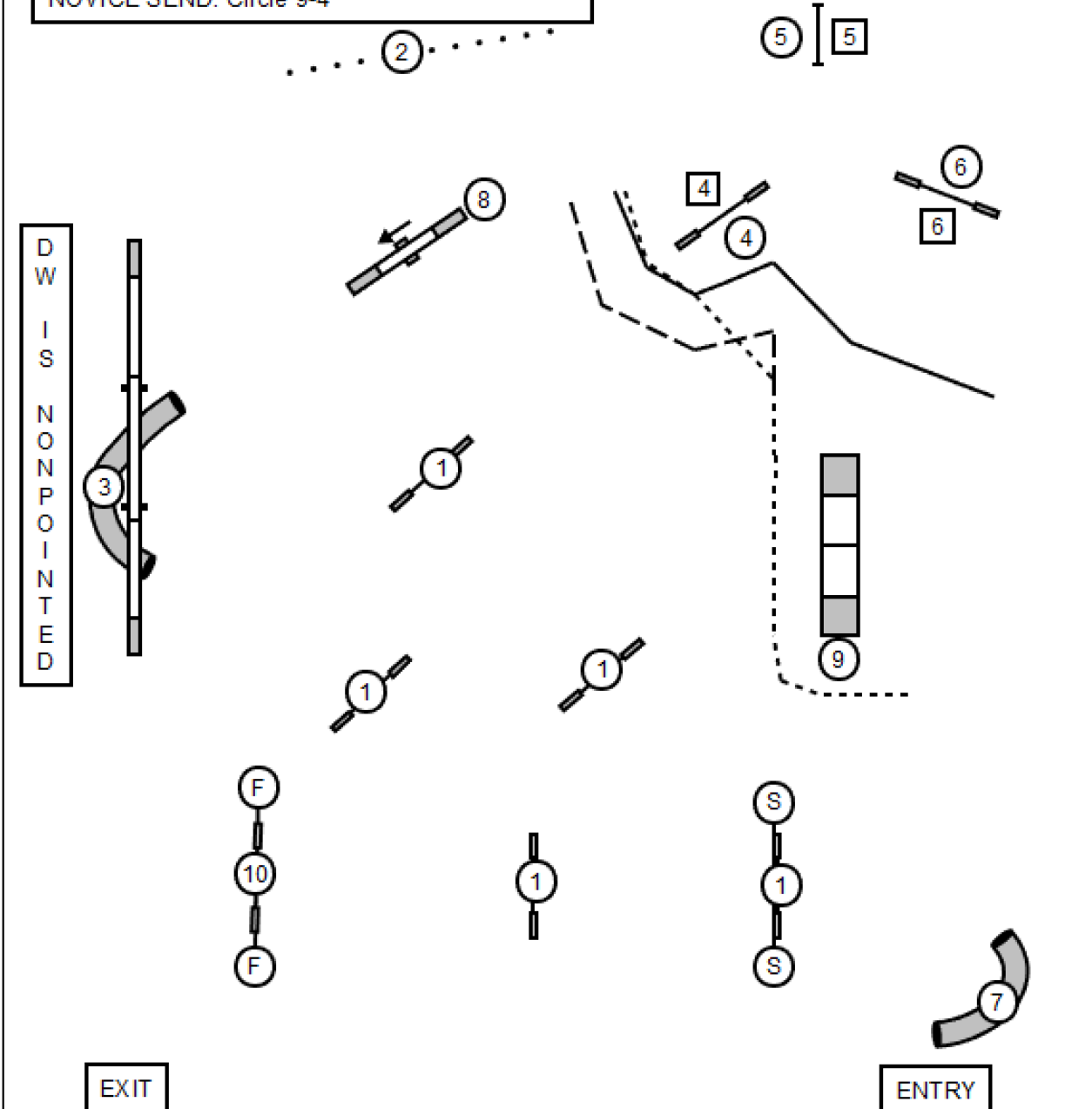

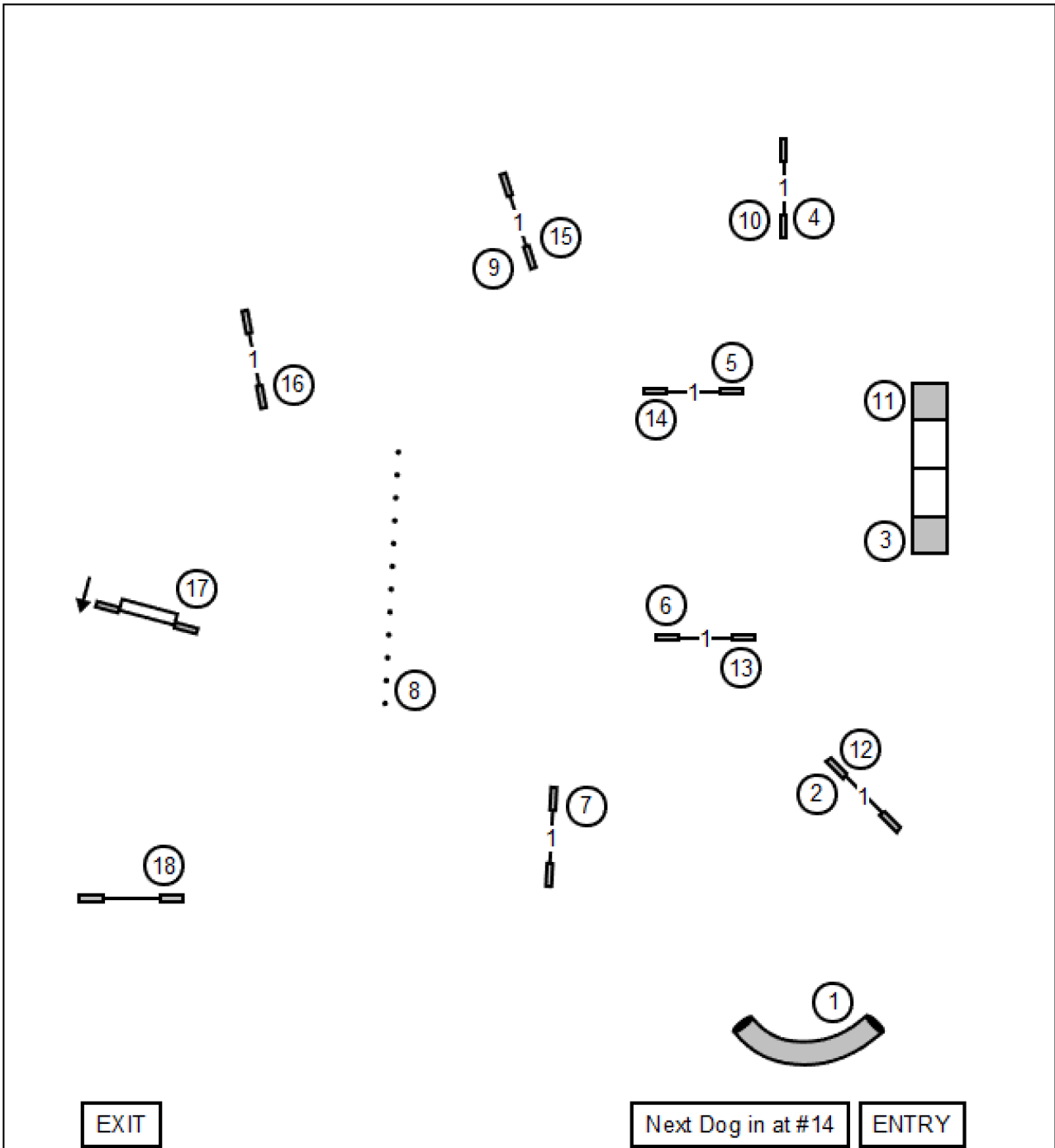
All obstacles are Bi-Directional except Teeter, Aframe, and as directed in your level send bonus.

NOVICE SEND: Circle 9-4



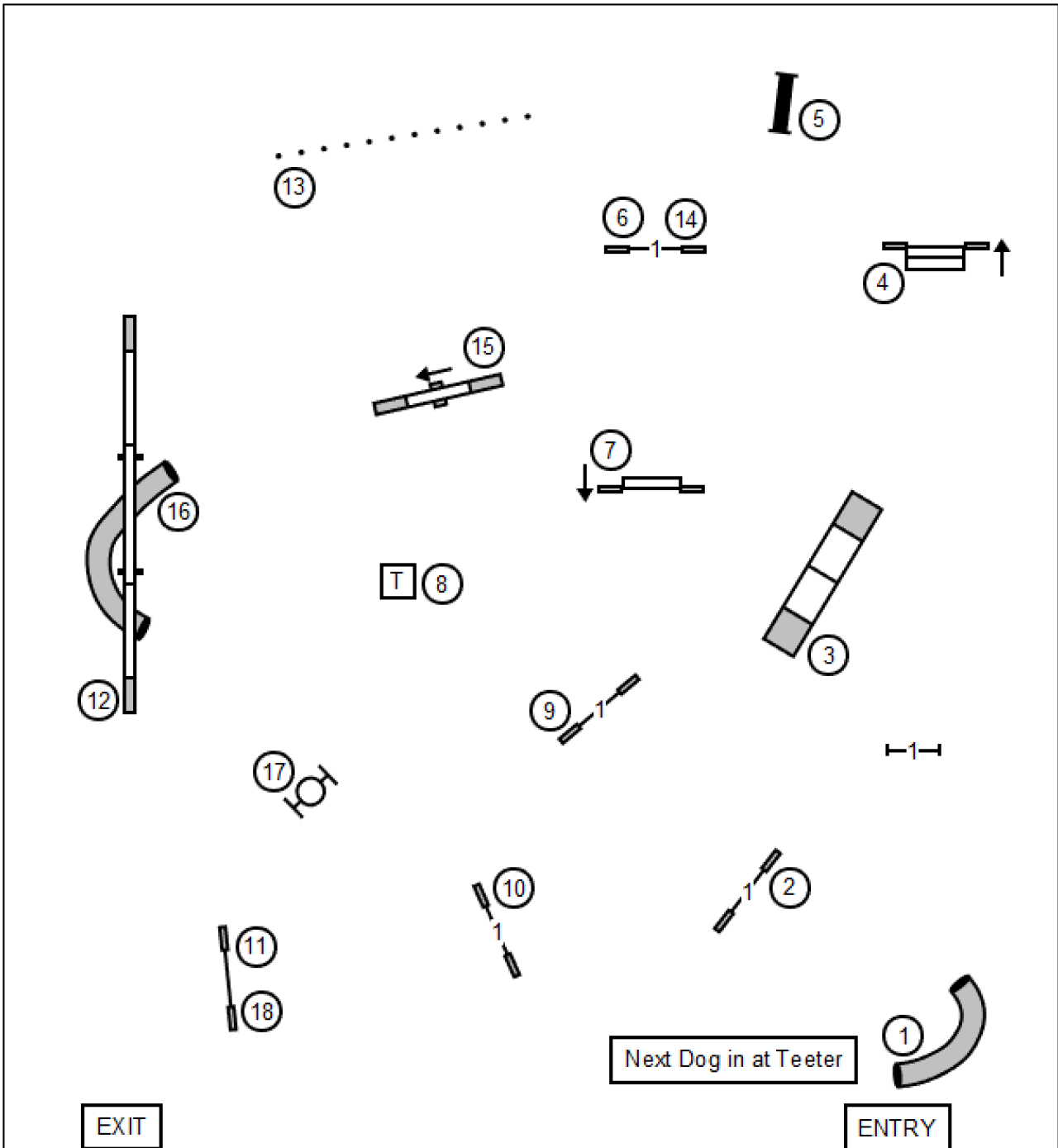

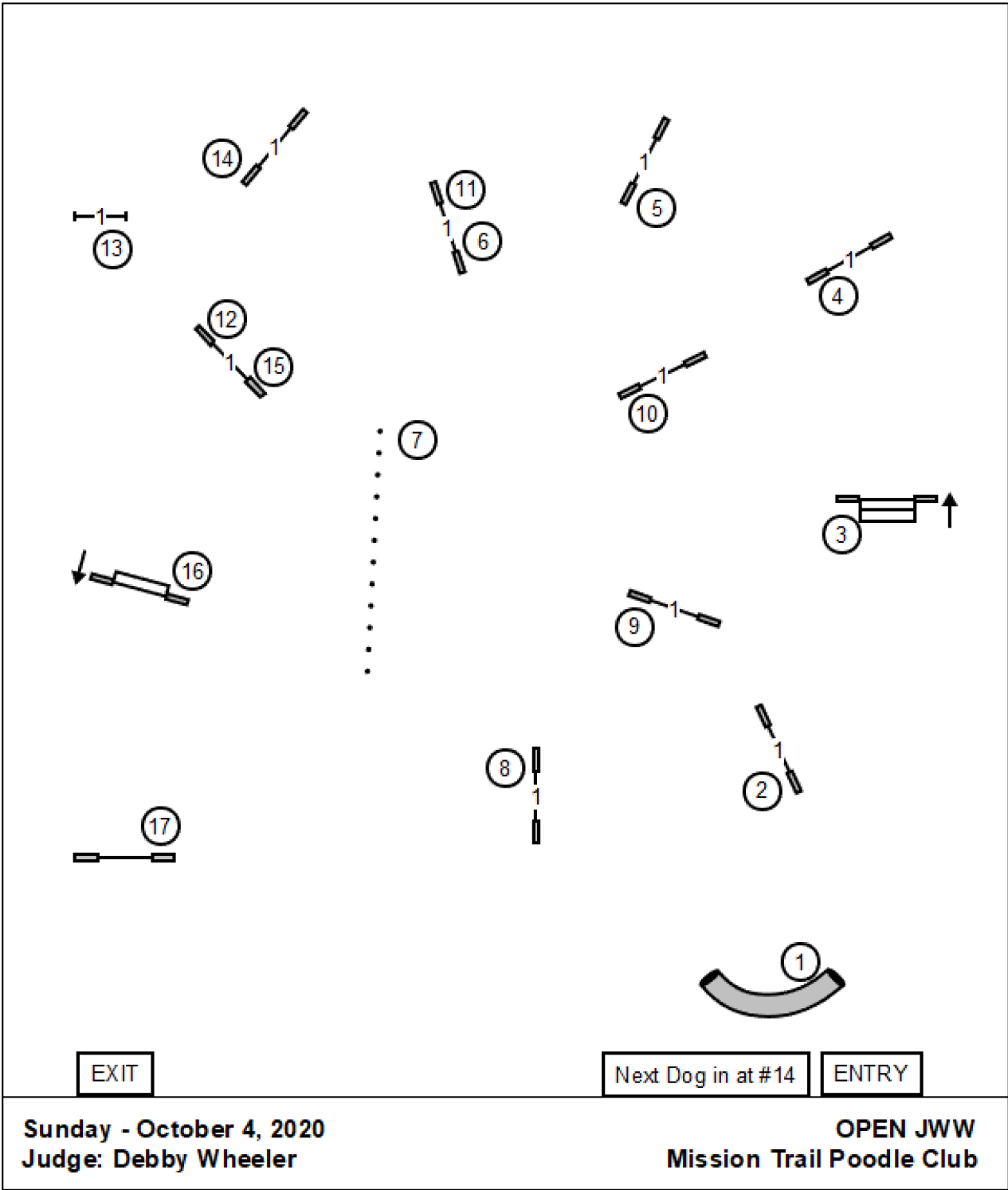
EXCELLENT MASTER STANDARD

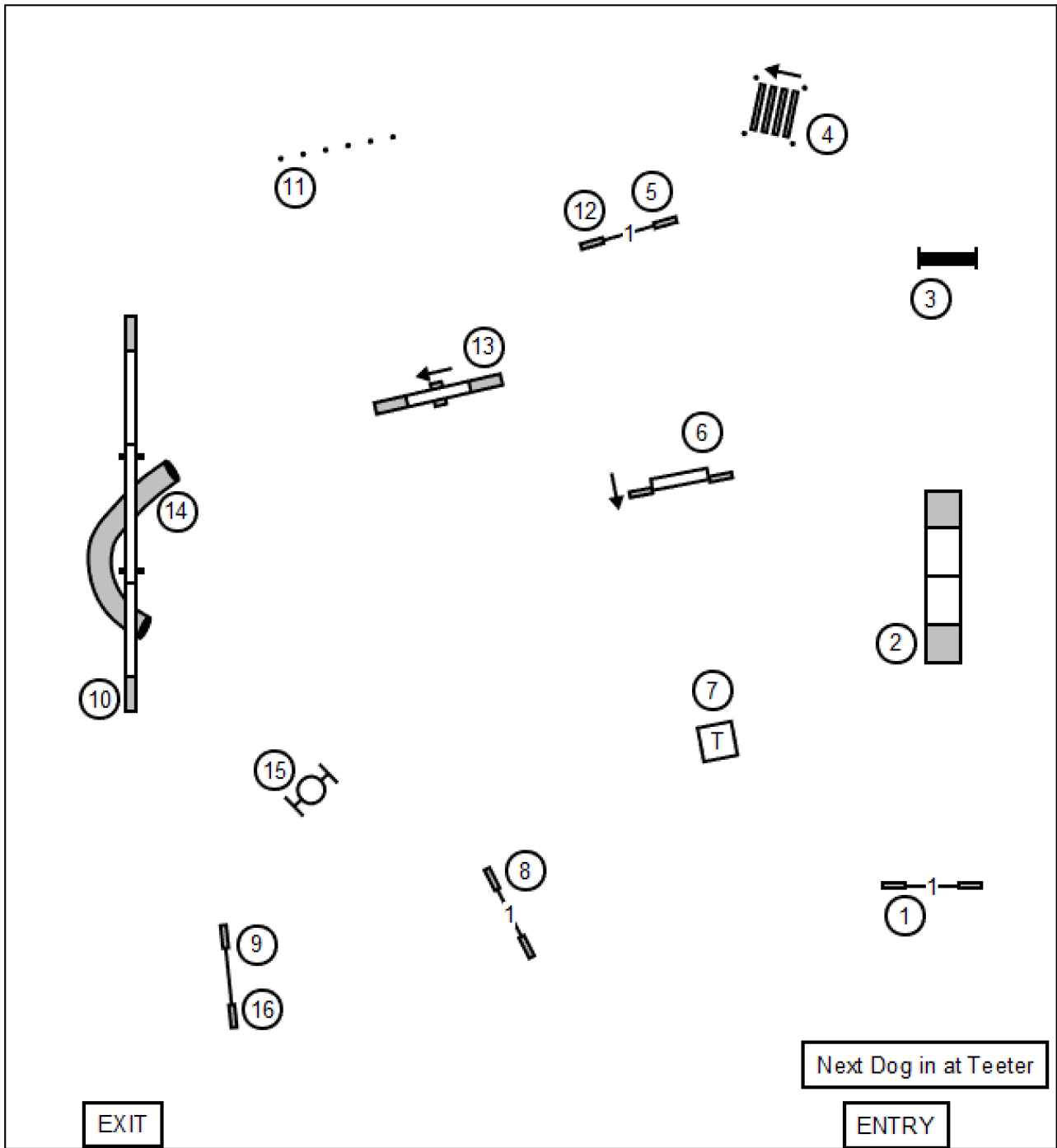

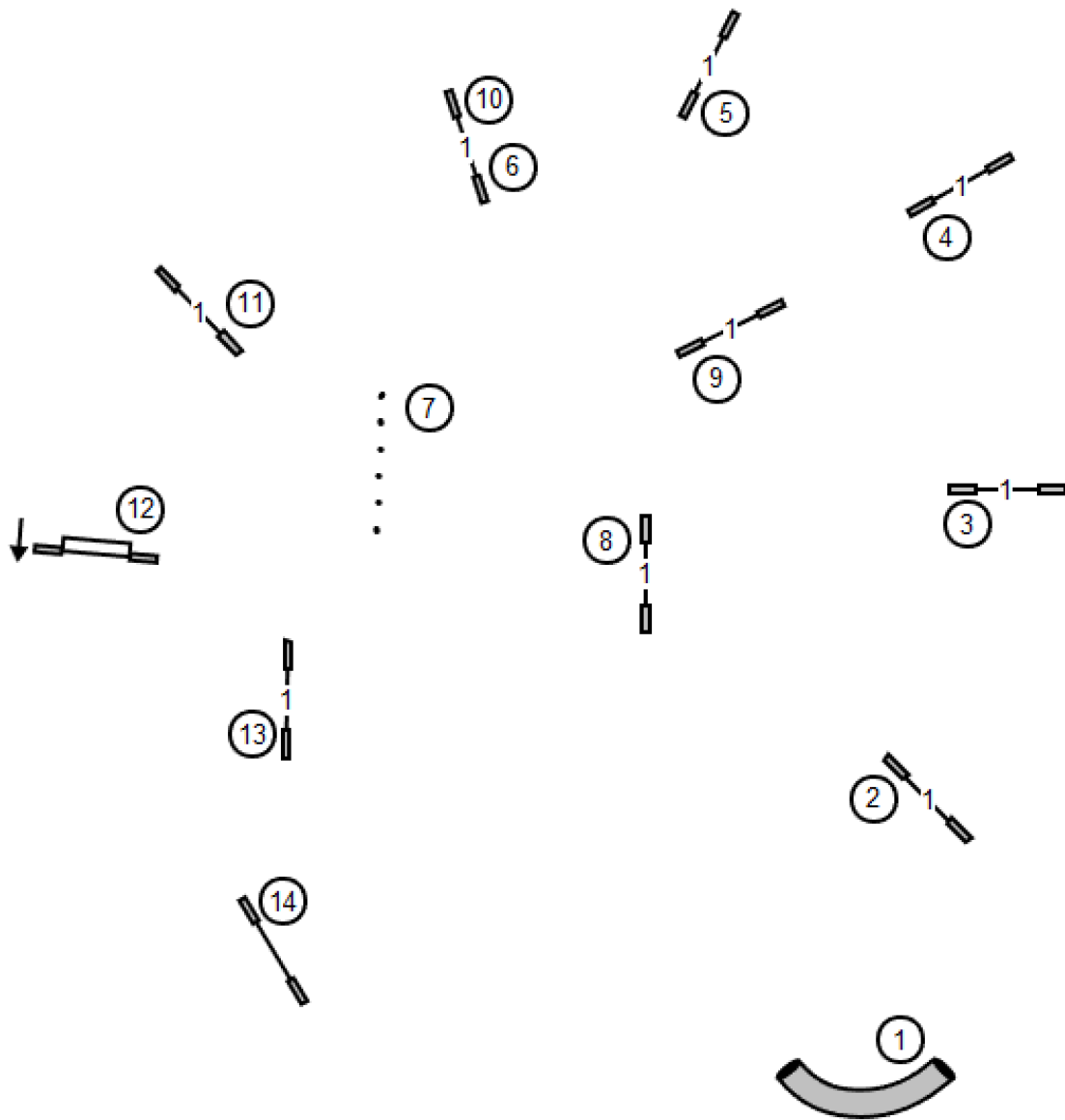

PARKING

There is a 5.00 parking charge PER DAY. It pays for the parking attendants required by the site.

GRASS

We are not allowed to potty our dogs on the grass.

MATS

All mats must be picked up each night so as not to kill the grass.

RV PARKING

A heads up to watch the top of your RV around the tight turns into the lot. There are some low hanging branches.

POND

Dogs are not allowed to swim in the pond. No humans either.

VINEYARD

We are not allowed to walk dogs in the vineyard.

COVID 19

If you are sick or if you know that you have been exposed to COVID-19 or if you are uncomfortable with the precautions we are taking, stay home – **we will give you a full refund.**

TEMPURATURE CHECK

We will be checking temperatures each day. When you arrive, before you unpack, immediately go to the trial secretary's area to get your temperature checked. When it is checked you will be given a wristband. You will not be allowed in the ring without a wristband.

AGILITY GATE APP

Go to http://dogagility.info/agility_gate to download the app and instructions on how to use it. To get the class information for this show only, we will send you the trial code by Wednesday. You can download the app before you get the code. Each night the maps will be loaded into the app.

NOTES ABOUT THE SHOW

- Masks/face coverings are required at all times, except when running your dog, when sitting under your ez-up or when you are in your car.
- Please be aware of who is around you and practice social distancing.
- We are not providing any hospitality. Workers need to bring their own food and drinks.
- We will provide sanitizer for our workers and the restroom, but exhibitors need to bring their own sanitizer.
- PPE – please take any personal protection equipment you use home with you. Do not put it in the trash cans.
- Bathrooms will be supplied with sanitizer, paper towels and disinfectant in the stalls. Do not put anything in the toilets besides toilet paper! The sink will have liquid soap. Please wash your hands. The exterior door will be propped open. Please leave it that way.
- Be prepared for the show to run slower than normal.
- **PLEASE SET UP WITH A MINIMUM OF 6' BETWEEN TENTS. Plenty of room, no need to be close to each other.**

HERE'S WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Crating - Set-ups are to be at least 6' apart. There is plenty of room. Help us make it as safe as possible.
- Maps - maps will be sent to you the evening before each show and will be on the website at the beginning of the judging schedule. Maps will be put on the Agility Gate app. Maps will be posted in two places at the show so you can take pictures of them. We will not have any printed maps available.
- Briefings –We will have a short briefing at the beginning of each group. For all briefings, the judge will be inside the ring. Everyone else will be outside the ring 6' apart.
- Measuring – it is not required that you be measured.

- Gate Steward – will be using the Agility Gate app. You can do everything on the app except move your dog around if you have multiple dogs in one jump height. The gate steward must do that at the gate.
- Going into the Ring – There will not be gates. There will be chutes. If you have a dog you think might try to leave the ring at the end of the run please have someone there to catch him.
- Masks/face coverings – you can remove your mask/face covering when you are in the ring. At the end of your run, put your dog's leash on inside of the ring. We will have an area marked off outside the exit gate where you can put on your mask – replace your mask before you leave this area!
- Face shields – if you chose to wear a face shield, please bring a mask for going in and out of the ring as there is no way to transport your face shield from the start to the finish.
- Leashes – leashes can go in your pocket or tied around your body tightly, so no ends flap around when running. If the ends come loose and flap around the judge will eliminate you. If you forget to bring a leash small enough to put in your pocket, we will have a limited number of veterinary style leashes. You can also leave your leash on the ground at the start line and a leash runner will transport it to the ground near the finish line with a leash grabber that will be sprayed with disinfectant.
- Results – will be posted on both sides of the trailer.
- Ribbons – will not be self-serve. There will be a ribbon station at the trial secretary's table with a person handing out ribbons and labels. Please line up 6' apart to get your ribbon.

WORKERS:

All worker stations will be equipped with sanitizer, gloves, and disinfectant.

All workers must use their own chair.

Timer/ scribe, gate steward, trial secretary, judge and ribbon areas will be taped off to keep access limited..

- Jump Setters – can choose to wear gloves or use sanitizer before you pick up and after you put down a jump bar
- Timers and scribes will sit 6' apart. Their area will be taped off so no one can get close to them. Please do not bother the timer/scribe. When finished they will wipe down the timer and table with disinfectant
- Gate Stewards will have their area taped off so no one can get within 6' of them.

NOVICE AND OPEN COMPETITORS, if you have any questions or need help with anything please come to the score table and someone there will be happy to help you. If this confirmation is confusing to you and you need some further explanation, contact Nicole Young at 916-715-0477 or email her at Ltapentries@gmail.com and she will help you make sense of it. If you have conflicts when running your dog or any problems at the show come to the secretary table and we will help you.

MOVE-UPS: All pre-show move ups must be received by 6pm, Monday, Sept 28. The AKC requires move-ups to be in writing. You may send an email for a move-up to agilityentry@mycci.net with your name, your dog's call name, the name & date of the trial and what class you want the dog to be moved to. If you miss the deadline for move-ups, you may move your dog up the first day of the show for any **subsequent** days even if you are not showing a dog that day. In addition a friend may do the move-up for you if you are not there. However you may not move up the day of the show for that day.

There will be day-to-day move-ups at the show provided the Trial Secretary receives them within 15 minutes after the end of the last class. **There will be no move-ups in the morning before the start of the trial.**

However, a dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions: The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from the Novice "A" class to the Novice "B" class.

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW: Sycamore Lane Kennels, 5111 W. Sargent Rd, Lodi, CA 95242

From I-5: Take Hwy 12 East toward Lodi, for 1.6 miles to Ray Road. Turn left on Ray Rd. and proceed for 1 mile to curve in road and turn left toward Sycamore Lane Kennels. Follow signs to site.

From HWY 99: Take Hwy 12 exit West (Kettleman Lane) toward Lodi. Go through Lodi about 5 miles to Ray Rd and turn right. Proceed for 1 mile to curve in road and turn left toward Sycamore Lane Kennels. Follow signs to site.

SET-UP ON FRIDAY MORNING:

No set up on Thursday. We are unloading the trailer and setting up rings at 6:30am on Friday. Any help would be greatly appreciated. Be sure and get your set-up vouchers before you leave General set-up is at 7:30am. Please do not put down your stuff before 7:30am if you are not helping to set up the rings

VOLUNTEERS: THANK-YOU, THANK-YOU, AND THANK-YOU. White boards will be set-up outside of the rings if you have some spare time. Julie O'Rourke and Karen Johnson are our chief ring stewards Volunteers will receive a \$2.00 voucher for each class worked. Volunteers who work the last class of the day will get a \$4.00 voucher. Volunteers please bring your vouchers and cash them in for a single voucher with the full amount worked for on it before you leave the show. At this time we will not be feeding workers.

MEASURING:

You do not have to be measured at this trial.

Our judge is a Volunteer Measuring Official for a permanent height card. She will measure your dog for an official measurement if you can stand 6 ft away while she measures your dog. She will be available to measure between classes. Come by the secretary table if you need help.
